All applicants must be pre-approved by the Examining & Licensing Committee prior to apprenticeship training. Pre-approval consists of submission of #1 & #2 of requirements.

REQUIREMENTS

The following must be submitted to the Cosmetology Association of New Brunswick before an instructor license can be issued:

- 1. All copies of diplomas or a transcript of marks indicating 12th grade education or GED;*
- 2. A resume indicating three years of continuous employment as a Certified Make-up Artist or a Certified Aesthetician in a Certified Cosmetology salon.*
- 3. Adequate knowledge of current Make-up skills through having attended upgrading courses, recent work or other means, to the satisfaction of the Examining & Licensing Committee.*
- 4. Standard registration fee: \$56.00; The fee is refundable up to 30 days after registration.*
- 5. Submission of a training course curriculum outline indicating method of instruction, hours of theory and practical training, satisfactory to the Examining & licensing Committee;*

By-Law A2.5 – Certified Aestheticians applying for an Instructor’s license are required to complete 30 days of apprenticeship training, no less than 160 hours, under a licensed instructor – Level II in a licensed school before receiving their certification, and/or a 3 credit University course in Adult education, at the discretion of the Examining and Licensing Committee.

(b) satisfying the Committee, by passing the examinations held pursuant to this Act, that the person possesses the required skills and knowledge to properly perform all the duties pertaining to the practice of cosmetology and to observe the proper rules of sanitation and hygiene in connection with the practice of cosmetology; and
