

Cosmetology Association of New Brunswick Examination Guidelines – Make-up

<p>1. The examination begins at ... sharp with registration of candidates at ...</p> <p>2. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the examining room for any reason after the exam has begun.</p> <p>3. Candidates who are not present when the exam starts will be required to register for another exam session at a later date. Consult the Executive Director of CANB to confirm a new examination date and time.</p> <p>4. Set-up for all elements will be done at the beginning of each exam .</p> <p>5. Failure to follow regulations & instructions could result in disqualification from the exam.</p>	
General Objective	<p>Everything you need to complete the tasks for each element. Professional products only.</p> <p>Borrowing of implements is prohibited, so please ensure your equipment is in good working order.</p> <p>No exceptions; please don't ask</p>
Candidate Identification	<p>Each candidate will be assigned a number to be displayed on his/her workstation so that it can be seen readily by examiners. No artificial nails</p>
<p>Equipment</p> <p>Borrowing of equipment is prohibited. No exceptions; please don't ask.</p>	<p>Everything you need to complete the tasks for each element. Professional products only.</p>
Models	<p>*Candidates are responsible for procuring their own models. If a model does not show up, the candidate will be disqualified from that element of the exam.</p> <p>Candidates may have female students (but no certified aestheticians or make-up artists) pose as models. If the model is a student, no coaching is permitted. The penalty for coaching is disqualification from the exam.</p> <p>Models must adhere to the following guidelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Models must have a clean face (no make-up products). 2. No sharing of models <p>Examiners prior to the start of the exam will scrutinize models. Penalty points may be assigned and candidate may be disqualified if model does not meet requirements</p>
Theory, By-Law, and Act exam	<p>The Theory exam will consist of 35 Multiple Choice questions and one diagram.</p> <p>The By-Law and Act exam consists of 25 Multiple Choice questions.</p> <p>Exam time is one hour (60 minutes).</p>
Core exam (If applicable)	<p>The theory exam consists of 26 multiple choices, core subjects only</p>
Professional Appearance	<p>Candidate should present a professional appearance and adhere to the following guidelines:</p> <p>Business casual dress, no short skirts or shorts, no jeans or sweatpants; no bare midriff, no t-shirts with objectionable slogans. School uniforms are welcomed</p> <p>Hair should be clean and styled</p> <p>Makeup should be fresh and moderate</p>
