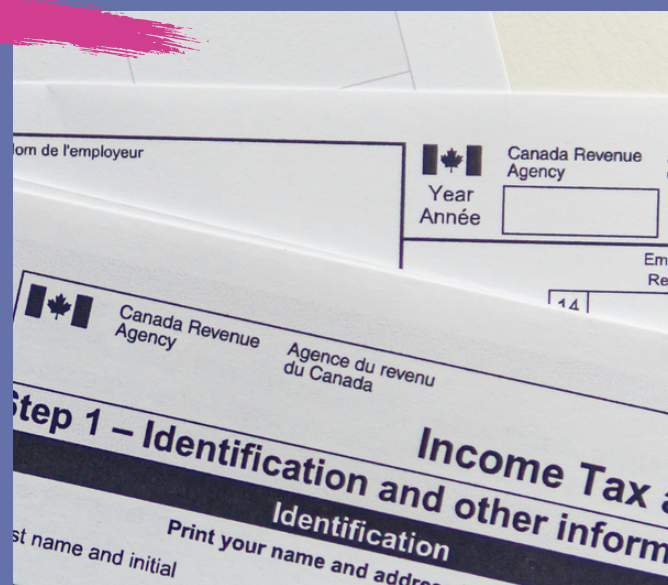


Income Tax Season

- Learn to develop practical tools to help support employees and colleagues who may be affected by DIPV.





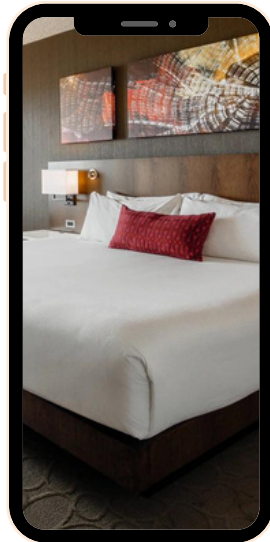
