- Raking in conditioner and leave-in treatments
- Retaining length when drying curls; diffusing, air and hood drying
- Product application techniques including setting curls with gel and the "Milk the Cow" technique

Module 5: Diffusing, Clipping & Volumizing Techniques (25 min)

- Benefits and limitations of each drying method (air drying, hood drying, diffusing, or a combination)
- Diffusing techniques and using a pick comb
- Krista's "Low & Slow" method
- Clipping techniques including roller jaw clamps, duck bill clips, DevaClips and pin curl clips
- Air drying and hood drying techniques

Module 6: Extra Tips, Refreshing Hair and Kids Curls (19.5 min)

- Demonstration on super curly/tightly coiled model

- Removing clips and teasing hair for volume

Course Evaluation

Knowledge Tests: A short quiz (8 to 10 questions) accompanies each module of the course to test the knowledge and lessons learned by the student.

Before & After Assignment: A series of 3 images showing the model's hair prior to applying course techniques, and after. Students are required to demonstrate their practical knowledge

of the 3 primary curl types: wavy, curly, super curly/tightly coiled. Submissions must also include an outline of the styling process used, styling products and amounts used to create the look in order to demonstrate applied learnings of the course.
